As I begin the new legislative session, I am proud to recap the successes achieved in 2022. Nine of my bills authored were signed by Governor Newsom, including measures to help expand housing opportunities in California, improve transparency in public service, and provide services to help some of our state's most vulnerable residents.

- **AB 408** K-12: Homeless Youth - School Liaisons
- **AB 498** Medi-Cal: Orange County Health Authority
- **AB 666** Mental Health: Workforce
- **AB 1595** Orange County Veterans Cemetery
- **AB 2221** ADU Reform
- **AB 2233** State Surplus Properties: Housing
- **AB 2508** K-12: Professional Counselors
- **AB 2827** K-12: Special Education – Access
- **AB 2256** Office of Broadband and Digital Literacy

I also secured \$16 million in budget resources to help improve the health and safety of many in who live in our community.

- \$6 million to the City of Fullerton for the Navigation Center Project
- \$5 million to the City of Buena Park for the New Municipal Water Well and Reservoir
- \$2 million to the City of Fullerton for the Women's Transitional Living Center
- \$2 million to the CSUF Center for Healthy Neighborhoods
- \$1 million to Korean Community Services for Three Mobile Health Clinics
